Voice and Performance Competition Celebrating the Legacy of Daniel Decatur Emmett

Competition Information and Rules:

- 1) All participants must be between the ages of 14 (as of January 1, 2016) and 29. You cannot be 30 years old before 12/31/15. Those that graduated from high school prior to 2015, are 19 years of age are, or are enrolled in college are in the 19-29 age group. Those that are younger than 19 years of age or did not graduate from high school prior to 2016 are in the 14-18 age group.
- 2) All participants must be a resident of Knox County for at least two years. Some exceptions apply, e.g. college students who live on campus, but maintain summer residences in Knox County will qualify.
- 3) All participants must have any accompaniment they are using available in mp3 format on CD (music ONLY, no vocals), unless the participant will be playing his/her own accompaniment.
- 4) Participants must be able to audition on Friday, August 5, 2016 at 7:00 pm (time approximate and will vary depending on the number of auditions). Auditions will be held in ThePlace@TheWoodward (101 South Main Street, Mount Vernon). The Knox Idol semifinalists will be selected at this audition by a panel of qualified judges. It is anticipated that the field of selected finalists will be approximately 50% male/female.
- 5) At the semi-finals, all contestants will perform one time, beginning with the younger age group. The audience will be asked to vote by ballot, with a donation of \$1 per ballot set, one ballot set per person. 100% of the donations will be given to the Woodward Opera House project. The first ballot will be to select the two top finalists for each age group.
- 6) The two finalists from each age group will perform a second time the following evening, using a different musical number. The second ballot will follow the second performance, where the winner and runner-up will be selected for each age group.
- 6) All individual performances shall be less than 5 minutes each. Performances are for vocalists only. Auditioners may accompany themselves. Instruments will not be provided. Backup bands or additional live accompanist(s) are not permitted.
- 7) The first place winners for YOUNG ADULT age category will receive the \$1,000 cash prize. The second place winners for this category will receive a cash prize of \$100.
- 8) The first place winners for YOUTH age category will receive the \$200 cash prize. The second place winners for this category will receive a cash prize of \$50.
- 9) Participants will be photographed and videographed during auditions and finals. Participants (or a parent/guardian if a minor) must give this permission in order to be eligible to enter the competition.
