

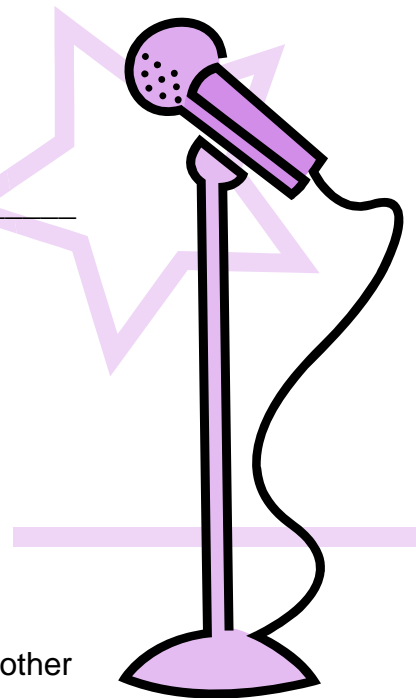

Voice and Performance Competition

Celebrating the Legacy of Daniel Decatur Emmett

Competition Information and Rules:

- 1) All participants must be between the ages of 14 (as of Jan. 1st, 2010) and 29. You cannot be 30 years old before 12/31/10. Those that graduated from high school prior to 2010, are nineteen years of age or older, or are enrolled in college are in the 19-29 age group. Those that are younger than 19 years of age *or* did not graduate from high school prior to 2010 are in the 14-18 age group.
- 2) All participants must be a resident of Knox County for at least two years. Some exceptions apply e.g. college students who live on campus, but maintain summer residences in Knox County will qualify.
- 3) All participants must have any accompaniment they are using available in mp3 format on CD, unless the participant will be playing his/her own accompaniment.
- 4) Participants must be able to audition on Thursday, July 22nd, 2010 at The Place @ The Woodward (111 South Main Street, Mount Vernon) at 7:00 p.m. (time approximate and will vary depending on the number of auditions). The Knox Idol finalists will be selected at this audition by a panel of qualified judges. It is anticipated that the field of selected finalists will be approximately 50% male/female.
- 5) At the finals, all finalists will perform one time, beginning with the younger age group. The audience will be asked to vote by ballot, with a donation of \$1 per ballot set, one ballot set per person. 100% of the donations will be given to the Woodward Opera House project. The first ballot will be to select the two top finalists for each age group. These two from each age group will perform a second time, using a different musical number. The second ballot will follow the second performance, where the winner and runner-up will be selected for each age group.
- 6) All individual performances shall be less than 5 minutes each. Performances are for vocalists only. Auditioners may accompany themselves. Instruments will not be provided. Backup bands or additional live accompanist(s) are not permitted.
- 7) The first place winners for ADULT age category will receive the Knox County Idol Award and a \$1,000 cash prize. The second place winners for this category will receive a cash prize of \$100 and 2nd place trophy.
- 8) The first place winners for YOUTH age category will receive the Knox County Idol Award and a \$200 cash prize. The second place winners for this category will receive a cash prize of \$50 and 2nd place trophy.
- 9) Participants will be photographed and videographed during auditions and finals. Participants (or a parent/guardian if a minor) must give this permission in order to be eligible to enter the competition.
